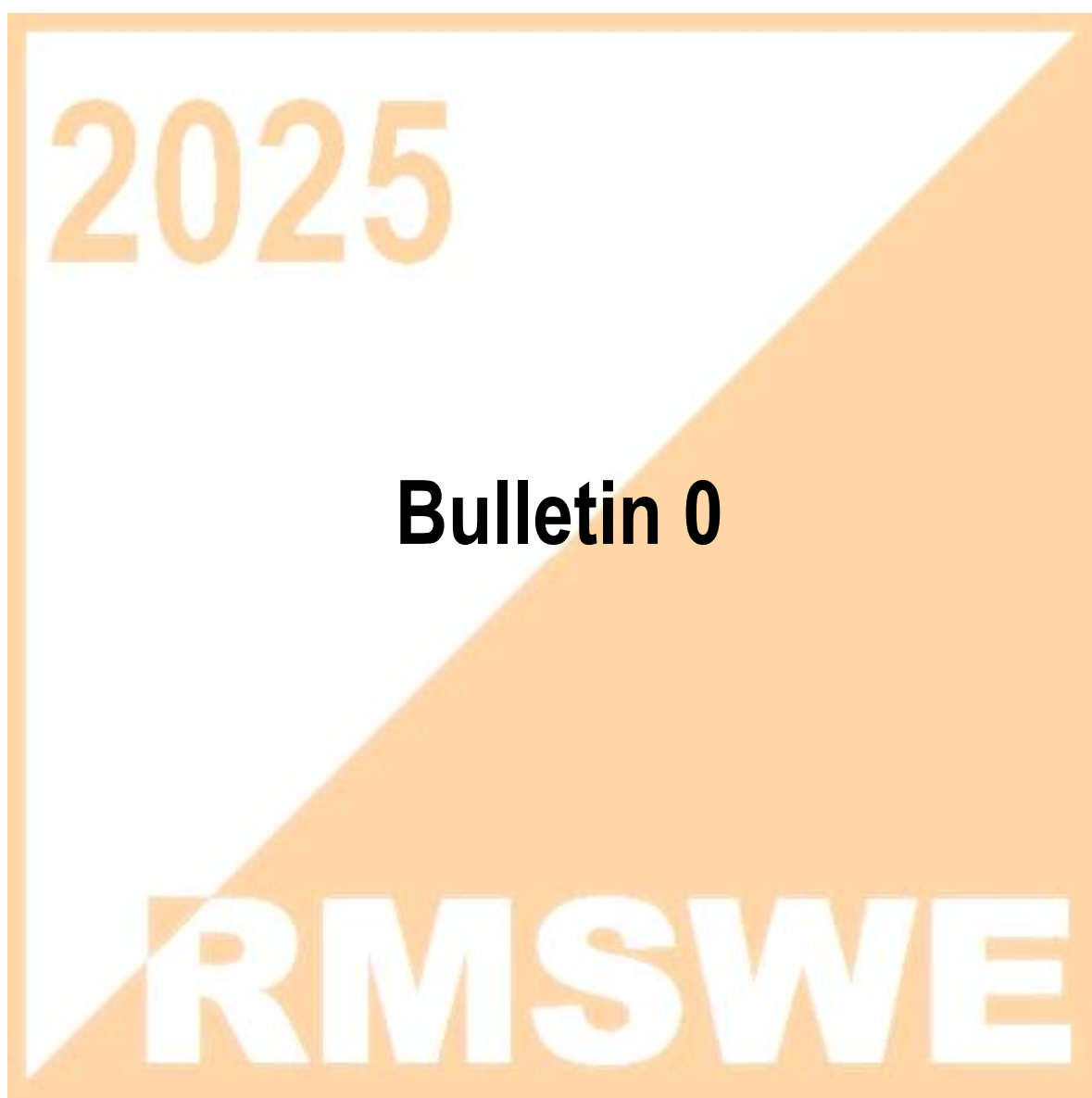

Competition center / Travel information

All competitions take place in the city of Offenbach (Main). The mass accommodation is also located in the city.

You can get there by public transport via Frankfurt Hauptbahnhof (Central Station) or Frankfurt Airport and from there by metro (S-Bahn) to Offenbach Marktplatz or by regional trains to Offenbach Hauptbahnhof (Central Station).

Offenbach is very easy to reach by car both nationally and internationally via the A3 and A661 motorways (exit Offenbach-Süd or exit Offenbach-Taunusing).

Rhein-Main Ranking List: The competitions of the RheinMainSprintWeekend on Sunday and Monday will each be scored individually for the Rhein-Main Ranking List.



Ranking categories: M/W-10, M/W-12, M-14 to M75- and W-14 to W75- (see also page 4)

The results of the categories M-10 / W-10 or M-12 and W-12 are combined for the ranking list. Accompanying runners are permitted in these classes.

Mass accomodation

We are offering a mass accommodation in the sports hall of an Offenbach school for the nights Saturday/Sunday and Sunday/Monday as a pure overnight offer. The runners have to provide their own air mattresses, sleeping bags and hygiene items etc. Breakfast is not provided.

The mass accommodation will be open from 7:00 p.m. in the evening until 9:00 a.m. the following morning.

The overnight stays must be booked together with the registrations in the O-Manager or via OrienteeringOnline. In exceptional cases, the booking can be made by email to meldung@gymnasium-offenbach.de.

History

International Offenbach Pentecost O

In 2008, actually on a whim, a club training of Gymnasium Offenbach was subsequently renamed as *International Offenbach Pentecost O*, as the seven participants came from four nations.

And since the idea was born, it was continued in the following years in a loose sequence. After a long break, the series was revived in 2023 with a public sprint training - and reached a record number of participants with 46 runners. Incidentally, this took place on part of our map "Schlosspark Rumpenheim", on which one of the two runs of the double sprint will probably be held.

With this motivation, the *International Offenbach Pentecost O* was offered again in 2024 as a public training session, although it had to be moved to Corpus Christi for scheduling reasons. Probably also due to the weather, we only managed to attract around 40 people willing to orienteer this time.

When we started planning our competitions for the new year at the end of 2024, it turned out that nobody had any plans for the Pentecost weekend in 2025, so after a short period of consideration we decided to take the opportunity to offer a 3-days O.

The now *6th International Offenbach Pentecost O* will serve as a prologue to the RheinMainSprintWeekend in 2025. As it is thus a kind of public training as a warm-up, it remains true to its origins - hopefully with a new record number of participants.

RheinMainSprintWeekend

The RheinMainSprintWeekend was held for the first time in 2017. The premiere also included four individual races in three competitions. The event was very successful from the start and always easily reached three-digit numbers of participants.

Before the pandemic, it took place annually at different locations, but with a similar program. Until now, the award ceremony for the previous year's Rhein-Main ranking list was always part of the weekend.

After a five-year break, the fourth edition will finally take place in 2025 as part of the 3-day orienteering event, which Gymnasium Offenbach is organizing at Pentecost. Due to the relatively late date in the year, the RMSWE will take place for the first time without the award ceremony for the ranking list, which is already scheduled for the end of March.

Nevertheless, the general conditions give hope for new record numbers of participants, as the RheinMainSprintWeekend is the only orienteering event at Pentecost 2025 in Germany.



Regulatory Notices

Participation in the events is at your own risk. The organizers and hosts are only liable in the event of gross negligence or intent on their part. All participants must ensure that they have adequate insurance cover (sports insurance, liability insurance).

The competitions take place in public traffic areas without closures for general (motor) vehicle traffic. There will be no closures. **The provisions of the German road traffic regulations must be strictly observed.** In accordance with the official permits in place, particular consideration must be given to pedestrians, visitors and tourists and participants must behave accordingly carefully and considerately.

Privacy Policy

The personal data provided during online registration will be stored and used for the purposes of carrying out and managing the event and for media reporting purposes. By registering, the participant consents to the storage of the data for this purpose.

The participant is advised that the event is a sporting event in which there is a public interest and recognizes that it is customary for participant result lists to be published in the media. The participant agrees to the publication of his/her surname, first name, year of birth, club and the pictures in which he/she is depicted in all reporting print media (participant list, result list, etc.) and in all electronic media such as the Internet.

If a participant does not give this consent or subsequently revokes it, this means that he/she cannot take part in the event.

The results will be passed on by the organizers to the respective organizers of the rankings (DOSV, ol-rhein-main.de) in order to calculate the ranking results and will be stored and further processed by them for this purpose.
